Maps are handed over at pre start (1 min before start) Individual start interval 2 minutes Starting order according to team accuracy Each teams 1st competititor starts first followed by 2nd and 3rd

Start order within teams to be determined by teams.

2.1 Individual overall

2.2. Team Overall

Total points of all three team members are added to get the team score. Winner is the team with the highest total score. Team Results are only given if all three team members have achieved an individual overall score.
